OFFICE FINANCIAL POLICY

If you have dental insurance, we are here to help you receive your maximum allowable benefits. In order to achieve these goals, we need your assistance and your understanding of our payment policy.

If we have received all of your insurance information on the day of the appointment, we will be happy to file your claim for you. You must be familiar with your insurance benefit, as we will collect from you the estimated amount insurance is not expected to pay. Your insurance is a contract between you, your employer, and the insurance company. We are not party to the contract; however, we will do what is legally allowed to help you attain your benefits.

We are not responsible for how your insurance company handles its claims or for what benefits they pay on a claim. We can only assist you on estimating your portion of the cost of treatment. We at no time guarantee what your insurance will or will not do with each claim. Payment for services is due at the time services are rendered unless otherwise discussed with our office.

Many consumers think that their insurance pays 90% to 100% of dental fees. In reality most plans pay 50% to 80% of the total fee. How much your insurance pays is controlled by your employer, not our office. Our fees fall within the acceptable range by most insurance companies, however many insurance companies reimburse their policyholders based on a fee schedule which has no relationship to the current standard of care.

It is always our intention to do what is best for your child regardless of your insurance coverage. Please feel free to discuss any questions or concerns you may have with us. We appreciate your understanding in this matter.
